

The WPGA Junior Foundation offers many tournament programs for all levels of play. You can also find more information about each tournament in the tournament description in Bluegolf.

Future Champions Tour- located around the state, this tour offers a 9 hole tournament experience. Juniors must be 14 years old and under to play on this tour. Juniors under the age of 12 must play in one Future tour event to qualify them to play in Junior Tour events. Age divisions are 12-14 and 11 & under for boys and girls. Juniors on this tour typically play from the forward to middle tees.

Junior Tour - This tour has events located all around the state of Wisconsin. Must be 18 years old and under to play and no handicap requirement. These events are 18 hole tournaments. Age divisions are 16-18, 14-15 and 12-13 for boys and girls. Course yardage is 6,000 - 6,300 for boys and 5,000 - 5,300 for girls.

Players Tour - The goal of the Players tour is to have the top junior players in the state compete on golf courses set up appropriately for high level of play. Inviations have been extended to the top finishers from the 2008 Player of the Year point list. Juniors must meet handicap to play on this tour. Boys must have index of 8.1 and under and girls must be under 18.1. Course yardage is 6,400 - 6,800 for boys and 5,300 - 5,900 for girls.

Pepsi Par 3 Tour - For juniors ages 18 and under. Played on Milwaukee County par 3 courses.

Sentry Insurance Classic - This is a girls only event. Open to girls 18 and under. Played at SentryWorld golf course in Stevens Point. Event is a precursor to the 2009 Solheim Cup in Chicago. The Solheim Cup is the LPGA Tour's version of the Ryder Cup. In 2008, we gave away 25 tickets to the Solheim cup. More tickets will be given away at this years event.

PGA Junior Championship - Our biggest junior event of the year. Played at Yahara Hills GC in Madison. Juniors play both east and west courses in a two-day 36 hole event. Boy and Girl overall winner then qualifies for national PGA Junior Championship at TPC River's Bend in Ohio.

Milwaukee County Parks Tour – For juniors 18 and under. Tournaments played at Milwaukee County Parks golf courses. 18-hole stroke play events.

Journal Sentinel Tournament – For juniors 18 and under. Juniors play 18-hole stroke play event in age divisions. Played at Currie Park GC.

Lake Arrowhead Invitational – Invite only based on player points accumulated throughout the summer.
