

WISCONSIN PGA MEMBER POINT SYSTEM

MEMBER POY POINT RULES:

a) In fields that involve more than WPGA members, such as the Wisconsin State Open & 18-Hole Classics, points are based off how a member finishes versus the other WPGA members in the field, with the exception of the examples below.

b) Points for the US Open Qualifiers and the Summer Showdown are based off of overall finish in the field and not the finish amongst the members.

c) Players must post an official score in order to be eligible for Wisconsin State Open points.

d) A-3 members are not eligible for points.

e) Members do not receive points for getting into a national or sectional event as an alternate, but may receive points based on finish.

f) Player of the Year and Nelthorpe Cup points run from January through December.

SENIOR POY POINT RULES:

- Members may earn senior points when they are at least 50 years of age and are in good standing as a Wisconsin PGA member.
- In fields that involve more than senior WPGA members, points are based off how a senior member finishes versus the other senior members in the field with the exception of the examples below.
- US Senior Open Qualifying points are based off the finish amongst the field and not WPGA senior members.
- WSGA / WPGA Summer Showdown points are based off the finish amongst the senior players in the field (Age 50 and over, professionals and amateurs).
- Players must post an official score in order to receive Wisconsin State Open points.
- A-3 members are not eligible for points.
- Members do not receive points for getting into a national or sectional event as an alternate, but may receive points based on finish.
- Bonus Points at the WPGA Professional Championship do not accumulate. Players will be awarded one or the other bonus based on how high they finish.
- Senior Player of the Year and Nelthorpe Cup points run from January through December.

WAGPA POINT SYSTEM

ASSISTANT POY POINT RULES:

- A-8 members, WPGA associates or pre-associates are eligible for assistant points when they are in good standing.
- In fields that involve more than WPGA assistants, points are based off how a assistant finishes versus the other assistants in the field with the exception of the examples below.
- WSGA / WPGA Summer Showdown and US Open Qualifying points are based off the finish amongst the field and not WAGPA members.
- Players must post an official score in order to receive Wisconsin State Open points.
- Assistants do not receive points for getting into a national or sectional event as an alternate, but may receive points based on finish.
- Assistant Player of the Year points run from January through December.
- The WI Royal Cup team will be determined off of YTD points after the State Open.

IN STATE EVENTS - ADDITIONAL POINTS

Qualify for the Wisconsin State Open (Includes being exempt) – 50 points
 Make 36-hole Wisconsin State Open Cut – 100 additional points
 Top 25 finish at Wisconsin State Open – 150 additional points
