- True / False 2. In stroke play, if a player returns a score for a hole higher than he has taken, he shall be disqualified. \_\_\_\_\_
- True / False 3. A player may purposely touch his ball in play with his club in the act of addressing it without penalty. \_\_\_\_\_
- True / False 4. In the rain, a player holds an umbrella over his head with one hand while holing a short putt with his putter held in the other hand; there is no penalty. \_\_\_\_\_
- True / False 5. Once a competition has started, the Committee may alter the conditions of competition in very exceptional circumstances. \_\_\_\_\_
- True / False 6. A player is not permitted to back into a branch of a tree causing it to move out of the way even if that is the only way that he can take his stance. \_\_\_\_\_
- True / False 7. A ball is lost if a player has played a provisional ball from a point nearer the hole than where the original ball is likely to be. \_\_\_\_\_
