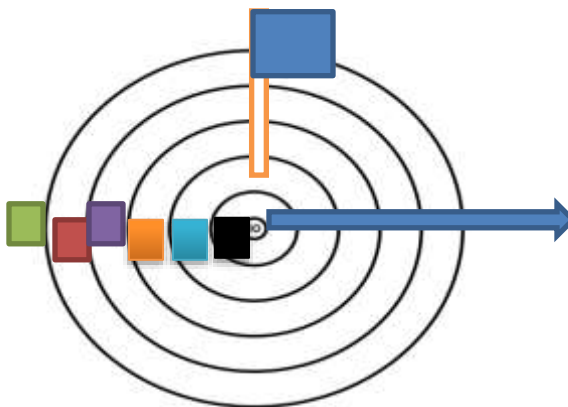

PUTTING

- There are designated practice areas – players are not allowed to practice at the putting station before or in between attempts. No coaching from parents is allowed.
- Call the player in order on the pairings sheet on your clipboard.
- If a player is present when called, it is his or her turn to play or they must withdraw, i.e. they can't trade spots or wait for a later turn to watch others play.
- Players will be given 40 seconds maximum to complete each putt.
- Each player will attempt one putt from each distance (**6 feet, 15 feet, and 30 feet**) in that order. Players place their golf ball in between the tee markers.
- Players can putt with the flagstick in or out, and change their mind in between attempts.
- When the ball comes to rest, the distance from the hole is converted to the points total.
- A ball coming to rest on any of the lines in the circle is **awarded the higher point total**.
- Clear each ball and let scorekeeper know the total points. Proceed to next attempt.
- AT MINIMUM, players get 1 point per putt, resulting in a minimum total of 3 points. You get a point for moving the ball.
- Record their score (add total points for three putts) **DIRECTLY** on their scorecard using a pen or sharpie. Record attempts **IN ORDER** (6 foot putt = attempt 1, 15 foot putt = attempt 2, and 30 foot putt = attempt 3).
- Instruct players to proceed immediately to **SCORING**.

GREEN: (1pt) Ball finishes more than 5' from hole
RED: (2 pts) Ball finishes 4-5' from hole
PURPLE: (5 pts) Ball finishes 3-4' from hole
ORANGE: (10 pts) Ball finishes 2-3' from hole
BLUE: (15 pts) Ball finishes 1-2' from hole
BLACK: (20pts) Ball finishes 1' or nearer to hole



Hole in One: 25 points!
