Nelthorpe Cup Matches Team Selection

Use the current Player of the Year Point system for both senior and regular participants.

Team is 16 players, selected as follows:

As of December 1st of current year, the following year's team will be selected. This should allow all national events for which points are allocated to be concluded.

The top 11 from Player of the Year points under the age of 50 from previous year will make the team. The 12th player will be the current WPGA Professional Champion. If the Champion is one of the top 11 players, the 12th player from the Player of the Year point list will make the team.

Top 4 players from the senior points will be selected providing 2 are at least 55 years of age as of December 1st. If less than 2 players in the top 4 are 55, then the next player that is 55 or older will be selected. All 4 seniors may be 55 or older, however 2 must be at least 55. Age is determined as of December 1st of playing year conclusion.

Seniors will be required to play in the senior portion of the event unless they only qualify for the team through the member point list.

Alternates:

If a regular or senior cannot play, they shall be replaced by the next person on the previous year's Player of the Year point list.

**All members of the Nelthorpe Cup team must be part of the Wisconsin Section and in good standing as of the date of the Nelthorpe Cup.

Royal Cup Matches Team Selection

Top ten Wisconsin PGA assistants versus the top ten Illinois PGA assistants.

Exhibition match is played in late September or early October; host site rotates between Illinois and Wisconsin.

Wisconsin team is selected using the Assistant Player of the Year point list.

The top ten players will be invited utilizing the points as they stand the day after the Assistant Pro Fall Classic. Assistant match play points accumulated up until this date will be included in the standings.

Substitutes will be added using the most current Assistant POTY list at the time a qualified player withdraws from the team.

**All members of the Royal Cup team must be part of the Wisconsin Section and in good standing as of the date of the Royal Cup.

TIES

If multiple players tie for the final spot on the Nelthorpe Cup or Royal Cup the following tiebreakers will be used:

Nelthorpe Cup (Member Portion) – 1st Tie Break – Section Championship Finish, 2nd Tie Break – State Open Finish.

Nelthorpe Cup (Senior Portion) – 1st Tie Break – Senior Section Championship Finish, 2nd Tie Break – State Senior Open Finish.

Royal Cup – 1st Tie Break – Assistant Championship Finish, 2nd Tie Break – State Open Finish.
