### 2025 WISCONSIN PGA PLAYER OF THE YEAR - RULES

#### APPLICABLE TO ALL CATEGORIES

- Player of the Year points run from January through December.
- A-3 members are ineligible for points.
- Nelthorpe Cup invitations will be based off the final standings of the prior year's Member & Senior Player of the Year races.
- Professionals do not receive points for getting into a national or sectional event as an alternate but may receive points based on their finish at the event.
- To earn points above the make cut minimum at the Wisconsin State Open or Wisconsin State Women's Open a player must post an official score.
- National PGA Professional Championship Points (Member, Senior & Assistant) will be awarded off the overall finish of the player versus the field.
- Championship Bonus Points will be awarded off the overall finish of the player versus the field. For Bonus Points a player will be assigned the highest value they qualify for. They do not accumulate.
- Bonus Points for the US Open, US Senior Open and US Women's Open qualifiers are based off of overall finish in the field and not the finish amongst the eligible players in the category. Bonus points for these qualifiers may accumulate.
- 18 Hole Classics All ties for first place in each category (Member, Senior or Assistant) will split points unless all players tied for low score in that category play-off. In that case the playoff winner would receive first place points and the playoff losers would split appropriate points for a tie for second.
- Memorial Classic & Assistant Professional Stroke Play Member, Assistant & Senior Points will be awarded by combining the fields of both events.
  - o A-8 members participating in the Assistant Professional Stroke Play or the regular division of the Memorial Classic will be eligible for both assistant and member points.
  - A-8 senior members participating in the Assistant Professional Stroke Play will be eligible member, assistant, and senior points.
  - A-8 senior members participating in the Memorial Classic will be eligible for;
    - Assistant points.
    - Member points if they sign up for the regular division of play in the Memorial.
    - Senior points if they sign up for the senior division of play in the Memorial.

#### **MEMBER CATEGORY SPECIFIC RULES**

- Awarded to Wisconsin PGA members in good standing. See the one exception below in the Senior specific rules about one-day classics.
- In fields that involve more than WPGA members, points are based off how the member finishes versus the other members in the field.
  - Exception US Open Qualifying and National event points are based off the finish amongst the field and not WPGA members.

#### SENIOR CATEGORY SPECIFIC RULES

- Awarded to Wisconsin PGA members in good standing, that are at least 50 years of age.
- In fields that involve more than senior WPGA members, points are based off how the member finishes versus the other senior members in the field.
  - o Exception US Senior Open Qualifying and National event points are based off the finish amongst the field and not WPGA senior members.
- In one-day classics, individuals that register for the senior division only will only be eligible for senior points and not member or assistant points.

#### ASSISTANT CATEGORY SPECIFIC RULES

- A-8 members and WPGA associates in good standing are eligible for assistant points.
- Pre-Qualifier/Qualifier Eligible approved tournament players are ineligible for points.
- The Wisconsin Royal Cup team will be determined off of year-to-date points as of the day after the Fall Assistant Classic.
- In fields that involve more than WPGA assistants, points are based off how an assistant finishes versus the other eligible assistants in the field.
  - o Exception US Open Qualifying and National event points are based off the finish amongst the field and not WPGA assistants.
- Assistant Professional Match Play
  - o Pre-Qualifier/Qualifier Eligible approved tournament players will not receive Match Play points if they become an associate during the event.
  - o Any associate or A-8 that changes classifications or gains membership during the Match Play portion, which then changes their eligibility, will be allowed to compete through the remainder of the matches/event. However, individuals in this type of situation will earn Assistant Player of the Year points up until their classification change. From that point forward they will be playing only for the purse and winner's trophy.

#### WOMEN'S CATEGORY SPECIFIC RULES

- Awarded to female Wisconsin PGA members in good standing.
- The WPGA will award a Women's Player of the Year honor if three of the eligible events on the possible point list feature multiple female WPGA member participants.
- Members must play in two different individual eligible events on the possible point list in order to be eligible for Section and National Points.
- Points for the WPGA Match Play, WPGA Championship and 18-Hole Classics / Match Play Q Round are based on the finish versus the WPGA members in the field.
