THINGS TO KNOW FOR 2027

MULTIPLE PACKAGES SEPARATE COURSE OFFERINGS

The WPGA will again offer two separate course packages/divisions. The Hearts Package will feature DragonRidge CC, Reflection Bay GC and the Paiute Golf Resort - Sun Mountain Course. The Diamond Package will consist of rounds at TPC Summerlin, SouthShore CC and Reflection Bay GC. All players will have lodging provided by Paris Las Vegas.

DIFFERENT PRICING FOR EACH PACKAGE/DIVISION

Due to the difference in golf fees in each package, the trip will offer different entry fees. Entry fees for each package can be found on page 4.

TWO OVERALL CONTESTS

With the multiple packages/divisions we will once again crown two overall champions. Teams will compete within their division/group from a daily and overall perspective.

CAPACITY

25 teams per division, 50 teams total.

REGISTRATION PROCESS

PRIORITY PROFESSIONALS

The two professionals from the defending champion teams along with professionals that have attended at least 8 of the past 10 Las Vegas Pro-Am are priority professionals for the 2027 trip. Priority professionals will have the chance to reserve a spot in the field before other WPGA members and associates receive the opportunity.

PRIORITY PROFESSIONALS HOW TO GUARANTEE YOUR SPOT

These individuals may officially reserve a spot in the field if they meet the following requirements:

- Accumulate at least 4 standard entries from the lottery list on the next page.
- Register and pay the \$150 professional priority fee. The payment will turn into a BlueGolf credit that does not expire and is good for tournaments or seminars.
- Have at least two amateurs register and pay during the deposit window.

LOTTERY AND PACKAGE ASSIGNMENT

After the priority professionals registration window closes and the other guaranteed spots are determined, the remaining spots will be drawn via lottery, if necessary. After the lottery is conducted a second drawing will be held to determine the specific package for each of the teams in the field. Professionals will be asked for the package preference of their group during their priority or lottery professional registration.

LOTTERY ENTRY RULES

- To qualify for the lottery a professional must earn 4 points from the list to the right.
- Register and pay the \$150 professional lottery fee. The payment will turn into a BlueGolf credit that does not expire and is good for tournaments or seminars.
- After the 4 standard points have been achieved, an individual may earn bonus entries.

SELECTED IN THE LOTTERY HOW TO GUARANTEE YOUR SPOT

- Have at least two amateurs register and pay during the deposit window.

DEPOSIT NOT FULFILLED

- If a professional in the field does not fulfill the team deposit requirement, they will forfeit the \$150 professional lottery or priority fee and not receive the BlueGolf credit.

STANDARD LOTTERY ENTRIES

- 1) Played in one of the past four Las Vegas Pro-Ams - 2023, 2024, 2025 or 2026.
- 2) One standard entry for each in-season WPGA event a professional participates in. Up to four entries via this opportunity.
- 3) Host a 2026 WPGA, WPGA Junior Foundation or Drive, Chip & Putt event.
- 4) Coach a 2026 PGA Junior League team.
- 5) Currently serves on either the WPGA or WPGA Junior Foundation board of directors.
- 6) Attend the WPGA Spring Meeting or the June GOLFTEC Teaching Summit.

2026 CHANGE - By earning 4 points, a professional will receive 1 entry into the lottery.

Once a professional qualifies for the lottery with their four standard entries, they can accumulate bonus lottery entries through multiple avenues. Such as being a Class A PGA member, a level 2 or 3 PGA associate, playing in at least 5 Las Vegas Pro-Ams, participating in one of our 2026 WPGA Professional Championships, playing in at least 10 WPGA tournaments in 2026, and hosting multi-day WPGA affiliated tournaments.

WHAT WILL HAPPEN IF DEMAND DOES NOT EXCEED CAPACITY?

If a lottery is not needed or the waitlist for the event becomes exhausted, any available spot(s) will be offered on a first deposit paid basis. Any WPGA member or associate can reserve these spots. In this case registration would be shut down and reopened at 8 am two days after the email and text notice is sent out to all WPGA professionals. The earliest this could happen is Wednesday, September 30.

REGISTRATION IMPORTANT DATES

Thursday, September 17

Priority professionals, sponsor teams, and the auction winner will receive the opportunity to register to reserve their spot. The window opens on Thursday, September 17 at 8 am and closes on Sunday, September 20 at 11:59 pm.

Monday, September 21

The professional lottery opens for registration at 8 am. Professionals will be asked to register online. The link to register will be sent out via email to all Wisconsin PGA Professionals. Professionals only need to enter once and the time of entry does not factor into the selection process. Lottery registration closes on Tuesday, September 22 at 11:59 pm.

Wednesday, September 23

The Wisconsin PGA will conduct the lottery at 2 pm and livestream it.

Thursday, September 24

DEPOSIT WINDOW - Thursday, September 24 at 8 am until Sunday, September 27 at 11:59 pm.

During this timeframe all professionals will be required to get two amateurs from their team to register and pay in full. This will guarantee the team spot. Registration links will be distributed via email to all professionals in the field on Thursday morning at 8 am.

Tuesday, September 29

Any professional that does not get their deposit paid in time will have their spot offered to the next team on the wait list.

Tuesday, December 1

All teams must be paid in full.

ADDITIONAL DETAILS

ONLINE REGISTRATION

- Registration for the trip will **ONLY BE AVAILABLE ONLINE. REGISTRATIONS ARE TAKEN INDIVIDUALLY.**
- Professionals will distribute the registration link to their amateurs to ensure they have the right link.
- Each amateur should go through the process and register themselves.
- Professionals in the field will use their BlueGolf login to register twice. The first will be the priority or lottery entry. The second, after the lottery, will be their actual event registration where lodging dates and sizes are collected.
- During the process amateurs should enter the name of their team professional, so we can align you with the right team.

LODGING - PARIS LAS VEGAS

Experience everything you love about Paris, right in the heart of the Strip. At Paris Las Vegas Hotel & Casino, you are transported to the City of Lights with the same passion, excitement, and ambiance of one of Europe's most iconic cities.

Each attendee will be provided four nights of lodging as a part of their package.

Additional nights may be added on to the specific package that is booked.

HOTEL EXTRA NIGHTS

The WPGA has a limited number of rooms held for shoulder nights. Room availability and rates are limited and may sell out at any time. No reservations for extra nights will be made until payment is received.

Room fee includes resort fee and tax. Fees are based on per room per night. During registration double occupancy individuals will have one person pay the entire room fee.

NO ROOM COMPS

Rooms in the block will not be eligible for comps. You may still receive comps for all other activities at the casino's discretion. If you are staying extra nights, you may book those on your own and arrange to have them comped. The best suggestion we recommend is to book the double occupancy package and one person stays in the Wisconsin PGA arranged room, while the other uses their comps.

EXTRA NIGHT CANCELLATIONS

Cancellations of an extra hotel night will be subject to a \$20 processing fee (per night). Cancellations after February 15 require the approval of Paris Las Vegas and could forfeit the entire room night fee.

TEAM CANCELLATION POLICY

Team cancellations before or on December 1 will be assessed a \$250 team cancellation fee. Cancellations from December 2 through January 4 will be assessed a \$500 team cancellation fee. Cancellations on or after January 5 will be responsible for the entire team trip price unless a replacement team is found (In this case the \$500 team cancellation fee still applies if a replacement team is found). If a team cancels after the initial deposit deadline the WPGA reserves the right to replace the team at any point. An Invoice for the cancellation fee will be sent to the team professional after the cancellation is received and will be due one month after the cancellation.

INDIVIDUAL AMATEUR REFUNDS \$130 (Single occupancy) \$100 (Double occupancy)

Any refund for an amateur entry fee will be subject to a \$130 processing fee for single occupancy fee or \$100 for double occupancy fee, regardless of timing.

If the refund is being issued due to a player substitution the refund will only be processed once the entry fee for the substituted player has been received.

In the case of a team cancellation fee, the processing fees are in addition to the team cancellation fee.

PROFESSIONAL ELIGIBILITY & SUBSTITUTIONS

Each team is required to have a Wisconsin PGA member or associate in good standing. They must remain in good standing from the time the lottery entry is accepted until the day the trip concludes. Professional substitutions will only be allowed in extenuating circumstances.

FORMATS AND PRIZES

Teams will play one round at each of their designated courses. For each round amateurs will receive 85% of their course handicap.

Daily team events on each course.
Professional daily stableford events.
Skins Games - Pro, Amateur Net, Amateur Gross

Prizes for the Monday and Tuesday daily events will be distributed the next day at the golf courses. Prizes for the Wednesday daily events will be distributed at Paris Las Vegas on Wednesday evening.



WPGA LIFE MEMBERS

WPGA Life Members may participate in the Las Vegas Pro-am on a team as an "amateur". The professional must have a World Handicap System handicap and will receive 85% of their course handicap. Any member playing on a team as such will receive the same prizes awarded to the other amateurs on the team and pay the applicable amateur entry fee.

PROFESSIONALS MEETING

There will be a mandatory virtual meeting for WPGA Professionals before departing for the trip. The purpose of the meeting is to go over the event schedule, formats & rules.

THE COMPETITION AND RULES

MULTIPLE TOURNAMENT YARDAGES

The Wisconsin PGA will again offer any senior amateur (50 and older) with a handicap index of 3.0 or higher or any amateur regardless of age with a handicap index 15.0 or above, the option to play an intermediate set of tees instead of the standard tees for the event. WPGA professionals 65 or older will also have this option. Players **MUST COMMIT** to play the intermediate yardage for the ENTIRE EVENT. Players may only change which tees they want to play up until two days prior to the event. Professionals will be contacted in mid-February to determine if any of their players will use this option. NOTE - Players utilizing this option will receive 2 to 4 less shots per round.

- Standard Tees - 6400-6600 yards approx.
- Intermediate Tees - 5950-6150 yards approx.

TEAMS & HANDICAPS

Each team will consist of one professional and four amateurs. All amateurs must have a World Handicap System handicap.

Handicap indexes to be used will be the 11/1/26 or 2/22/27 revision. The lower of the two indexes will be used. Maximum handicap strokes per player is 24.

If an individual has posted 12 scores between 11/1/26 and 2/22/27, the lower of their 1/22 & 2/22 indexes will be used.

The WPGA reserves the right to modify handicap indexes, based on score history of the past year and past history in this tournament.

- Performance from in-state WPGA pro-ams will also be factored into event handicaps.
- A handicap reduction formula will be in place and it will result in reductions for players during the event.
- Any player that has not posted a score since June 1 will receive a 15% reduction on their index prior to the event starting. Minimum one-shot reduction.
- Players need to have at least seven scores posted over the past year (2/23/26 to 2/22/27) or they will only receive 75% of their handicap index.
- Event indexes will be capped at 3.0 more than the player's low index over the past 10 1/2 months (Since April 1).
- At the conclusion of the event each individual daily score will be posted to the player's handicap record.
- Plus handicaps will play to their converted number.
